- 4 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 69.50
- 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) A retailer licensed under this chapter may use a vending
- 7 machine for the retail sale of useable marijuana, marijuana
- 8 concentrates, and marijuana-infused products, subject to approval from
- 9 the board prior to the installation or use of the machine in the
- 10 licensed premises.
- 11 (2) The board is granted general authority to adopt rules
- 12 necessary for the implementation of this section, including, but not
- 13 limited to, rules governing:
- 14 (a) The operational characteristics of the vending machines;
- 15 (b) Identification and age verification processes and requirements
- 16 for customers who make purchases from the machines;
- 17 (c) The location of vending machines within the licensed premises
- 18 and measures to prevent access to the machines by persons under age
- 19 21;
- 20 (d) The types and quantities of marijuana-related products that
- 21 may be purchased from the vending machines; and
- 22 (e) Signs and labeling that must be affixed to vending machines
- 23 pertaining to public health and safety notifications, legal warnings
- 24 and requirements, and other disclosures and information as deemed
- 25 necessary by the board.
- 26 (3) The products sold through vending machines, and the use of
- 27 such machines, must comply with the pertinent provisions of this

- 1 chapter regarding the retail sale of useable marijuana, marijuana 2 concentrates, and marijuana-infused products.
- 3 (4) For the purposes of this section, "vending machine" means a 4 machine or other mechanical device that accepts payment and:
- 5 (a) Dispenses tangible personal property; or
- 6 (b) Provides a service to the buyer.

- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 69.50 9 RCW to read as follows:
- 10 (1) A retailer licensed under this chapter is prohibited from 11 operating a drive-through purchase facility where marijuana 12 concentrates, marijuana-infused products, or useable marijuana are 13 sold at retail and dispensed through a window or door to a purchaser 14 who is either in or on a motor vehicle or otherwise located outside of 15 the licensed premises at the time of sale.
- 16 (2) The state liquor control board may not issue, transfer, or 17 renew a marijuana retail license for any licensee in violation of the 18 provisions of subsection (1) of this section."

EFFECT: (1) Authorizes the use of vending machines by a licensed marijuana retailer, provided such use is approved by the Liquor Control Board and complies with specified regulations; and (2) strikes the criminal penalty for the unlawful operation of a drivethrough purchase facility at the premises of a licensed marijuana retailer, but allows for monetary and other regulatory sanctions by the Liquor Control Board for such violations.
