- Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the 1 2 following:
- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 72.09 3 RCW to read as follows: 4
- 5 The department, in conjunction with the department licensing, must provide offenders with a state-issued identicard 6 7 pursuant to RCW 46.20.117.
- (2) An offender is eligible for an original, renewal, 8 replacement identicard under this section if he or she: 9
- (a) Has been sentenced to a term of confinement totaling more 10 than one year and committed to department custody; 11
- (b) Is confined within a state correctional facility and has at 12 least sixty days remaining on his or her confinement term as of the 13 effective date of this section; 14
- 15 (c) Has not waived his or her right under this section to an 16 identicard;
- (d) Does not have a current and valid state-issued identification 17 18 card; and
- (e) Is a United States citizen or is lawfully present within the 19 United States. The department of licensing must verify the status of 20 21 an applicant through either the systematic alien verification for entitlements program or through verification of the applicant's 22 social security number with the United States social security 23 2.4 administration. A person may prove his or her citizenship by 25 providing a valid, unexpired United States passport or passport card, a certified copy of a birth certificate, a consular report of birth 26 abroad issued by the United States department of state, a certificate 27 28 of naturalization issued by the department of homeland security, or a 29 certificate of citizenship. A person may prove his or her lawful 30 presence within the United States by providing documentation that he 31 or she is an alien:
- (i) Lawfully admitted for permanent or temporary residence in the 32 United States; 33

- 1 (ii) With conditional permanent resident status in the United 2 States;
- (iii) Who has an approved application for asylum in the United 3 States or has entered into the United States in refugee status; 4
  - (iv) Who has a valid nonimmigrant status in the United States;
- 6 (v) Who has a pending application for asylum in the United 7 States;

- (vi) Who has a pending or approved application for temporary 8 protected status in the United States; 9
- (vii) Who has a pending application for lawful 10 permanent residence or conditional permanent resident status; or 11
- (viii) Who has approved deferred action status from a deferred 12 action program established before November 20, 2014. A person with 13 approved deferred action status from a program established before 14 November 1, 2014, that is based on any expansion of eligibility 15 criteria to the deferred action program that occurred after November 16 17 20, 2014, is not an acceptable form of lawful presence under this subsection (2). 18
- (3) An offender's valid identification card issued by the 19 department may serve as sufficient proof of identity and residency 20 21 under RCW 46.20.035 to obtain a state-issued identicard pursuant to RCW 46.20.117. 22
- (4) An offender receiving a state-issued identicard pursuant to 23 24 this section must pay a fee as established in RCW 46.20.117 to the department to offset the cost of obtaining the identicard. Provided 25 26 such action does not reduce an offender's account below the indigency 27 level, such costs may be paid or deducted from the offender's gross wages, gratuities, or the offender's personal inmate savings account. 28 29 If an offender's inmate account is below the indigency level, or would become below the indigency level as a result of paying such 30 31 fee, the department may pay or subsidize the cost associated with issuing the identicard to the offender. 32
- **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.20.117 and 2012 c 80 s 6 are each amended to read 33 34 as follows:
- 35 (1) **Issuance**. The department shall issue an identicard, 36 containing a picture, if the applicant:
- 37 (a)(i) Does not hold a valid Washington driver's license;
- ((<del>(b)</del>)) <u>(ii)</u> Proves his or her identity as required by RCW 38 46.20.035; and 39

- 1 (((c))) (iii) Pays the required fee. Except as provided in (b) of this subsection and subsection (5) of this section, the fee is forty-2 five dollars from October 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, and fifty-four 3 dollars after June 30, 2013, unless an applicant is a recipient of 4 continuing public assistance grants under Title 74 RCW, who is 5 6 referred in writing by the secretary of social and health services. 7 For those persons the fee must be the actual cost of production of the identicard; or 8
- 9 (b) Qualifies for an identicard under section 1 of this act.
- (i) An identicard issued under this subsection (1)(b) expires one 10 year from the first anniversary of the offender's birth date after 11 12 issuance.
- (ii) The department may charge the department of corrections a 13 fee of the amount appropriate to cover the cost of production of an 14 identicard issued under this subsection (1)(b). 15
  - (2) **Design and term**. The identicard must:

- 17 (a) Be distinctly designed so that it will not be confused with the official driver's license; and 18
- (b) Except as provided in subsection (1)(b) or (5) of this 19 section, expire on the sixth anniversary of the applicant's birthdate 20 21 after issuance.
- Renewal. An application for identicard renewal may be 22 (3) 23 submitted by means of:
  - (a) Personal appearance before the department; or
  - (b) Mail or electronic commerce, if permitted by rule of the department and if the applicant did not renew his or her identicard by mail or by electronic commerce when it last expired.

An identicard may not be renewed by mail or by electronic commerce unless the renewal issued by the department includes a photograph of the identicard holder.

- (4) Cancellation. The department may cancel an identicard if the holder of the identicard used the card or allowed others to use the card in violation of RCW 46.20.0921.
- (5) Alternative issuance/renewal/extension. The department may 34 issue or renew an identicard for a period other than five years from 35 October 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, or six years after June 30, 2013, 36 or may extend by mail or electronic commerce an identicard that has 37 already been issued, in order to evenly distribute, as nearly as possible, the yearly renewal rate of identicard holders. The fee for an identicard issued or renewed for a period other than five years

An identicard may not be renewed by mail or by electronic commerce unless the renewal issued by the department includes a photograph of the identicard holder.

- (4) Cancellation. The department may cancel an identicard if the holder of the identicard used the card or allowed others to use the card in violation of RCW 46.20.0921.
- (5) Alternative issuance/renewal/extension. The department may 10 11 issue or renew an identicard for a period other than five years from October 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, or six years after June 30, 2013, 12 or may extend by mail or electronic commerce an identicard that has 13 already been issued, in order to evenly distribute, as nearly as 14 possible, the yearly renewal rate of identicard holders. The fee for 15 an identicard issued or renewed for a period other than five years 16 from October 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, or six years after June 30, 17 2013, or that has been extended by mail or electronic commerce, is 18 nine dollars for each year that the identicard is issued, renewed, or 19 extended. The department may adopt any rules as are necessary to 20 21 carry out this subsection.
- 22 NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. Section 2 of this act expires August 30, 23 2017.
- 24 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** Section 3 of this act takes effect August 25 30, 2017.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. Except for section 3 of this act, this act 26 27 is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its 28 existing public institutions, and takes effect July 1, 2015." 29
