1 Beginning on page 5, line 32, strike all of section 4 and insert
2 the following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 70.240
4 RCW to read as follows:

5 (1) Beginning July 1, 2016, at the request of the department, a
6 manufacturer of residential upholstered furniture or children's
7 products shall, within sixty days of the request, submit a
8 certificate of compliance stating that the product or product
9 component meets the requirements of section 1 of this act. A
10 manufacturer required under any other state statute to provide a
11 certificate of compliance may develop one certificate containing all
12 required information.

13 (2) The certificate of compliance must include the following:

14 (a) Chemical names and chemical abstracts service registry
15 numbers for all chemicals present in the product or product component
16 that act as flame retardants; and

17 (b) The signature of an authorized official of the manufacturing
18 company.

19 (3) A manufacturer completing a certificate of compliance shall
20 keep a copy of the certificate on file for as long as the product or
21 product component contains flame retardants. If a manufacturer ceases
22 to sell or distribute products or product components containing flame
23 retardants, the manufacturer must retain the certificate on file for
24 three years from the date of the last sale or distribution."

EFFECT: Authorizes the department of ecology to request
manufacturers to submit certificates of compliance for restricted
flame retardants.

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
