

**SSB 6246 - S AMD 677**

1 On page 181, line 2, increase the General Fund- -State FY 2017  
2 appropriation by \$44,861,000 and adjust the total appropriation  
3 accordingly.

5 On page 193, line 36, increase the General Fund- -State FY 2017  
6 appropriation by \$1,421,000 and adjust the total appropriation  
7 accordingly.

8  
9 On page 197, line 3, increase the General Fund- -State FY 2017  
10 appropriation by \$6,262,000 and adjust the total appropriation  
11 accordingly.

12  
13 On page 216, after line 13, insert the following:

14 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 515.** A new section is added to 2015 3rd sp.s. c  
15 4 (uncodified) to read as follows:

16 The appropriations to the office of superintendent of public  
17 instruction in part V of this act shall be expended for the programs  
18 and in the amounts specified in this act. However, the office may  
19 expend unexpended funds from the grades kindergarten through three  
20 class size reduction funds in part V of this act for the purpose of  
21 providing one-time beginning teacher salary increases. The  
22 resulting compensation shall not exceed a total annual salary of  
23 \$40,000 for full-time equivalent certificated instructional staff  
24 with zero years of service and a bachelor of arts degree. The  
25 surrounding cells of the salary allocation model in LEAP document 1  
26 may be modified so that a reduction in salary does not occur for  
27 staff promoting to the next step. The office may modify LEAP

1 document 2 to account for this change only to the extent that the  
2 unexpended funds can support the salary adjustments. Before making  
3 modification to the salary allocations, the office will submit a  
4 report detailing its proposed adjustments to the appropriate policy  
5 and fiscal committees of the legislature and the office of financial  
6 management."

8       Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any  
9 internal references accordingly.

EFFECT: Funding from the K-3 class size reversion is restored  
and provided for a one-time beginning teacher salary increase.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$52,544,000 GF-S FY 2017
