**Brief Description:** Relating to insurance for providers of commercial transportation services.

**Brief Summary of Bill**

- Establishes insurance requirements for providers of commercial transportation services, using a personal vehicle.

**Background:**

A consumer's personal automobile insurance covers his or her private passenger automobile, which is an individually-owned motor vehicle that is not used as a public or livery conveyance for passengers and is not rented to others. A "livery" is a common design or paint scheme used by a company. Personal automobile insurance does not cover commercial use of a vehicle.

**Summary of Bill:**

Insurance requirements for those who provide commercial transportation services using personal vehicles are addressed.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Fiscal Note:** Not requested.
