SB 5723

Brief Description: Concerning the amendment, recodification, decodification, or repeal of statutes relating to state capital construction funds and accounts and bond authorizations that are inactive, obsolete, or no longer necessary for continued publication in the Revised Code of Washington.

Sponsors: Senators Honeyford and Keiser; by request of State Treasurer and Office of Financial Management.

Brief Summary of Bill

- Amends, recodifies, decodifies, or repeals statutes related to state capital construction funds, accounts, and bond authorizations that are inactive, obsolete or no longer necessary for continued publication in the Revised Code of Washington.

Background:

Chapter 251, Laws of 2013 (SSB 5287) required the Office of the State Treasurer, the Office of Financial Management, and the Code Reviser to review state statutes related to state capital construction funds, accounts and bond authorizations. Based on the review, they were required to submit legislation in 2015 to amend, repeal, or decodify statutes that are inactive, obsolete, or no longer necessary for continued publication in the Revised Code of Washington (RCW).

Summary of Bill:

A number of statutes related to state capital construction funds, accounts, and bond authorizations that are inactive, obsolete or no longer necessary for continued publication in the Revised Code of Washington are decodified, recodified, amended, or repealed.

This analysis was prepared by non-partisan legislative staff for the use of legislative members in their deliberations. This analysis is not a part of the legislation nor does it constitute a statement of legislative intent.
