

SENATE BILL REPORT

2ESHB 1299

As of Second Reading

Title: An act relating to transportation funding and appropriations.

Brief Description: Making transportation appropriations for the 2013-2015 and 2015-2017 fiscal biennia.

Sponsors: House Committee on Transportation (originally sponsored by Representatives Clibborn and Fey; by request of Governor Inslee).

Background: The operating and capital expenses of state transportation agencies and programs are funded on a biennial basis by an omnibus transportation budget adopted by the Legislature in odd-numbered years. Additionally, supplemental budgets may be adopted during the biennium, making various modifications to agency appropriations.

Summary of Bill: Appropriations are made for state transportation agencies and programs for the 2015-17 fiscal biennium. Additionally, the 2013-15 biennial appropriations for various transportation agencies and programs are modified.
