1 **Sec. 2.** RCW 69.50.4013 and 2013 c 3 s 20 are each amended to 2 read as follows:

- (1) It is unlawful for any person to possess a controlled substance unless the substance was obtained directly from, or pursuant to, a valid prescription or order of a practitioner while acting in the course of his or her professional practice, or except as otherwise authorized by this chapter.
- 8 (2) ((Except as provided in RCW 69.50.4014,)) Any person who 9 violates this section is guilty of a ((class C felony)) misdemeanor 10 punishable under chapter 9A.20 RCW.
- 11 (3) The possession, by a person twenty-one years of age or older, 12 of useable marijuana or marijuana-infused products in amounts that do 13 not exceed those set forth in RCW 69.50.360(3) is not a violation of 14 this section, this chapter, or any other provision of Washington 15 state law.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. RCW 69.50.4014 (Possession of forty grams or less of marihuana—Penalty) and 2003 c 53 s 335 are each repealed.
