HOUSE BILL 1320

State of Washington 64th Legislature 2015 Regular Session

By Representatives Goodman and Moscoso; by request of Department of Corrections

Read first time 01/19/15. Referred to Committee on Public Safety.

AN ACT Relating to creating an identicard program for certain incarcerated offenders; amending RCW 46.20.117 and 46.20.117; adding a new section to chapter 72.09 RCW; creating a new section; providing effective dates; providing an expiration date; and declaring an emergency.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

7 NEW SECTION. The legislature intends to create an Sec. 1. identicard program to provide incarcerated offenders with a state-8 9 issued identicard to assist and prepare each offender for release 10 from prison and reentry into the community. The legislature finds 11 that each step that assists individuals being released from prison helps incarcerated offenders avoid predictable conditions that lead 12 to future recidivism and that a reduction in recidivism makes the 13 14 community safer, transforms formerly incarcerated offenders into 15 productive citizens, and strengthens the family structure that 16 surrounds each offender. The goal of the identicard program is to 17 provide proper state identification to offenders upon release to the 18 community, which is critical for accessing services, employment, 19 housing, and various other opportunities in the community.

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 72.09
 RCW to read as follows:
 - (1) The department, in conjunction with the department of licensing, must implement an identicard program to provide offenders with a state-issued identicard pursuant to RCW 46.20.117 at no cost to the offender.

The department may issue or renew an identicard for a period other than five years from October 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, or six years after June 30, 2013, or may extend by mail or electronic commerce an identicard that has already been issued, in order to evenly distribute, as nearly as possible, the yearly renewal rate of identicard holders. The fee for an identicard issued or renewed for a period other than five years from October 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, or six years after June 30, 2013, or that has been extended by mail or electronic commerce, is nine dollars for each year that the identicard is issued, renewed, or extended. The department may adopt any rules as are necessary to carry out this subsection.

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. Section 4 of this act takes effect August 30, 2017.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. Except for section 4 of this act, this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect July 1, 2015.
