- 1 AN ACT Relating to allergen information in schools; adding a new
- 2 chapter to Title 28A RCW; and providing an effective date.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1) The legislature finds:
- 5 (a) One in every thirteen children have potentially life threatening allergies;
- 7 (b) A person is sent to the emergency room due to food allergies 8 every three minutes in the United States;
- 9 (c) Studies show that from 1997 to 2007 allergies increased 10 eighteen percent among children under age eighteen;
- 11 (d) Food allergies are the leading cause of anaphylaxis outside 12 of the hospital setting;
- 13 (e) The economic cost of children's food allergies in the United 14 States is twenty-five billion dollars per year.
- 15 (2) The purpose of this chapter is to protect students with food 16 allergies and to inform students and parents about the ingredients 17 used in preparing meals at school.
- 18 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. As used in this chapter:

- 1 (1) "Allergen" means any substance that causes an allergy 2 including, but not limited to, gluten, wheat, peanuts, pine nuts, 3 tree nuts, seafood, and dairy.
- 4 (2) "Allergen information" means a list of all of the ingredients 5 in food served at the public school.
- 6 (3) "Public school" has the meaning provided in RCW 28A.150.010.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. Public schools must display allergen information on a conspicuous sign in a prominent place within each
- 9 area where food is served.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** Sections 1 through 3 of this act 11 constitutes a new chapter in Title 28A RCW.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** This act takes effect September 1, 2015.
