- 1 AN ACT Relating to the use of student housing facilities at the
- 2 institutions of higher education by homeless students; amending RCW
- 3 59.18.040; adding a new section to chapter 28B.15 RCW; and creating a
- 4 new section.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that:
- 7 (1) Students who are homeless or were homeless face more barriers 8 to achieving higher education than other students;
- 9 (2) Providing access to higher education, especially for low-10 income persons, is a fundamental purpose of government; and
- 11 (3) Institutions of higher education have the ability to address 12 this problem by allowing low-income homeless students to live in
- 13 student housing facilities free or for a reduced fee while the
- 14 facilities are not being used by students who are paying student
- 15 housing fees.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.15
- 17 RCW to read as follows:
- 18 The governing boards of the institutions of higher education may
- 19 authorize temporary use of student housing facilities, without charge
- 20 or at a reduced fee, by low-income homeless students attending that

- 1 institution during such time as those facilities are otherwise unused
- 2 by students who are paying student housing fees. For purposes of this
- 3 section, "low-income" may be defined by the institutions and
- 4 "homeless" has the same definition as "homeless person" in \mathtt{RCW}
- 5 43.185C.010.
- 6 Temporary occupation of student housing facilities by low-income
- 7 homeless students is subject to the terms and conditions developed by
- 8 the institution.
- 9 **Sec. 3.** RCW 59.18.040 and 1989 c 342 s 3 are each amended to 10 read as follows:
- The following living arrangements are not intended to be governed
- 12 by the provisions of this chapter, unless established primarily to
- 13 avoid its application, in which event the provisions of this chapter
- 14 shall control:
- 15 (1) Residence at an institution, whether public or private, where
- 16 residence is merely incidental to detention or the provision of
- 17 medical, religious, educational, recreational, or similar services,
- 18 including but not limited to correctional facilities, licensed
- 19 nursing homes, monasteries and convents, and hospitals;
- 20 (2) Occupancy under a bona fide earnest money agreement to
- 21 purchase or contract of sale of the dwelling unit or the property of
- 22 which it is a part, where the tenant is, or stands in the place of,
- 23 the purchaser;
- 24 (3) Residence in a hotel, motel, or other transient lodging whose
- operation is defined in RCW 19.48.010;
- 26 (4) Rental agreements entered into pursuant to the provisions of
- 27 chapter 47.12 RCW where occupancy is by an owner-condemnee and where
- 28 such agreement does not violate the public policy of this state of
- 29 ensuring decent, safe, and sanitary housing and is so certified by
- 30 the consumer protection division of the attorney general's office;
- 31 (5) Rental agreements for the use of any single-family residence
- 32 which are incidental to leases or rentals entered into in connection
- 33 with a lease of land to be used primarily for agricultural purposes;
- 34 (6) Rental agreements providing housing for seasonal agricultural
- 35 employees while provided in conjunction with such employment;
- 36 (7) Rental agreements with the state of Washington, department of
- 37 natural resources, on public lands governed by Title 79 RCW;
- 38 (8) Occupancy by an employee of a landlord whose right to occupy
- 39 is conditioned upon employment in or about the premises;
