- 1 AN ACT Relating to the distribution of naloxone to persons at
- 2 risk for opioid overdose; and adding a new section to chapter 69.50
- 3 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 69.50 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) There shall be a fee of ten cents placed upon each sale at 8 retail of prescription opioids. Receipts from the sale shall be 9 remitted to the department of revenue at the same time as the 10 pharmacy remits its business and occupations tax.
- 11 (2) The department of revenue shall deposit all receipts from the 12 fee in subsection (1) this section in the naloxone access account 13 established in subsection (3) of this section.
- 14 (3) The naloxone access account is created in the state treasury.
 15 All receipts from the fee in subsection (1) of this section must be
 16 deposited into the account. Moneys in the account may only be spent
 17 after appropriation. Expenditures from the account may only be used
 18 for the department of health to administer the naloxone access grant
 19 program and distribute grants to local health jurisdictions.
- 20 (4) The department shall establish the naloxone access grant 21 program to distribute funds to local health jurisdictions to purchase

naloxone and distribute it to persons at highest risk for opioid overdose. The department shall establish all necessary procedures to administer the naloxone access grant program, including establishing application procedures, adopting scoring criteria for grant applications, and distributing grants from the naloxone access

account to successful applicants.
