- 1 AN ACT Relating to payroll cards; and adding a new chapter to
- 2 Title 19 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.
- 7 (1) "Consumer" means an employee whose wages are paid to a 8 payroll deposit account established through the employee's current 9 employer.
- 10 (2) "Financial institution" means any bank, credit union, trust 11 company, or any other person that holds a payroll deposit account or 12 that issues a payroll card. An employer that uses payroll cards as a 13 method of wage payment is not a financial institution solely by 14 virtue of such use.
- 15 (3) "Maintenance fee" means a recurring periodic fee charged to a 16 consumer on a payroll deposit account.
- 17 (4) "Payroll card" means a prepaid card or other device used by a 18 consumer to access wages in a payroll deposit account.
- 19 (5) "Payroll deposit account" means a prepaid account that is 20 established at the request of an employer and to which electronic 21 funds transfers of the consumer's wages, salary, or other employee

- 1 compensation are made on a recurring basis, whether the account is
- 2 operated or managed by the employer, a third-party payroll processor,
- 3 a depository institution, or any other person.
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 2. (1) No financial institution may issue a payroll card to a consumer unless the provisions of this section are
- 6 met.
- 7 (2) The financial institution must provide the consumer with the 8 ability, without cost, to access the balance in the consumer's
- 9 payroll deposit account online and over the telephone.
- 10 (3) The financial institution may not charge the consumer a
- 11 maintenance fee on the payroll deposit account while the consumer
- 12 receives electronic funds transfers of wages from the employer that
- 13 established the account, and for sixty days thereafter.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** (1) An agreement made in violation of the
- 15 provisions of this chapter or requiring any person to violate this
- 16 chapter is contrary to public policy and is void and unenforceable.
- 17 (2) This chapter applies to agreements and transactions made on
- 18 or after January 1, 2017.
- 19 NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. Sections 1 through 3 of this act
- 20 constitute a new chapter in Title 19 RCW.
- 21 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** If any provision of this act or its
- 22 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 23 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 24 persons or circumstances is not affected.
