- Sec. 1. (1) The council of presidents, the state 5 NEW SECTION. 6 board for community and technical colleges, and the institutions of 7 higher education as defined in RCW 28B.10.016(4), shall convene a disability work group, including representatives from statewide 8 student associations and the student achievement council, to bring 9 10 forward recommendations for assisting students with temporary or
- 11 permanent disabilities. 12 (2) The recommendations should focus on challenges for students
- 13 transferring between institutions including, but not limited to:
- 14 Creating more standardized terminology among institutions
- 15 disability services, improving the ease of locating disability
- 16 services contact information online, and developing best practices
- 17 for institutions to reach out to and help prepare students for
- transmitting accommodations information and documentation to their 18
- 19 next institution.
- 20 (3) The institutions of higher education as defined in RCW
- 21 28B.10.016(4) shall begin implementing the recommendations of the

- disability work group required in subsection (2) of this section as soon as is practicable, but no later than December 31, 2016.
- 3 (4) The work group must provide its report to the relevant 4 committees of the legislature no later than December 31, 2016.
  - (5) This section expires August 1, 2017.
