

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 2015-4639, by Representative Parker

1 WHEREAS, Jeremy Affeldt is a prominent citizen of Spokane,
2 Washington, who strives to better the community in which he lives
3 through both professional endeavors and personal example; and

4 WHEREAS, In his professional baseball career, Affeldt has played
5 for the Kansas City Royals, the Colorado Rockies, the Cincinnati
6 Reds, and the San Francisco Giants, where he started his career with
7 a scoreless inning and held a twenty-eight inning scoreless streak
8 from May 8, 2009, to July 24, 2009; and

9 WHEREAS, Affeldt holds three World Series Rings from 2010, 2012,
10 and 2014, in which he closed game seven, sealing the season victory
11 for the Giants; and

12 WHEREAS, Throughout his career with the Giants, Affeldt has
13 recorded a scoreless outing in twenty-two consecutive postseason
14 games, the second longest streak in Major League Baseball history;
15 and

16 WHEREAS, Off the field, Affeldt is a strong advocate for ending
17 child poverty, encouraging others to stir a movement in the cause of
18 helping the suffering and marginalized; and

19 WHEREAS, In 2009, Affeldt donated five thousand dollars to the
20 Not For Sale campaign to open a medical clinic in Thailand for former
21 child slaves and participated in the Free2Play campaign, donating
22 \$100 for every strikeout to the nonprofit; and
