- 1 AN ACT Relating to surgical technologists; amending RCW
- 2 18.215.005 and 18.215.010; adding new sections to chapter 18.215 RCW;
- 3 and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.215.005 and 1999 c 335 s 1 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 The registration and professional education of surgical
- 8 technologists is in the interest of the public health, safety, and
- 9 welfare.
- 10 **Sec. 2.** RCW 18.215.010 and 1999 c 335 s 2 are each amended to 11 read as follows:
- The definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.
- 14 (1) "Department" means the department of health.
- 15 (2) "Secretary" means the secretary of health or the secretary's designee.
- 17 (3) "Surgical technologist" means ((a person, regardless of
- 18 title, who is supervised in the surgical setting under the delegation
- 19 of authority of a health care practitioner acting within the scope of
- 20 his or her license and under the laws of this state)) an individual

- 1 who under the supervision of a licensed health care practitioner in a
- 2 hospital as defined by RCW 70.41.020 or an ambulatory surgical
- 3 <u>facility as defined by RCW 70.230.010 is authorized to: (a) Maintain</u>
- 4 <u>surgical instrument integrity from within the surgical field during</u>
- 5 <u>surgical procedures;</u> (b) <u>perform surgical support tasks, including</u>
- 6 <u>instrument and equipment transfers and counts and managing fluids</u>,
- 7 specimens, and supplies; (c) identify and correct breaks in asepsis;
- 8 and (d) perform other surgical tasks as directed.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 18.215 10 RCW to read as follows:
- 11 In order to perform functions in a hospital licensed under
- 12 chapter 70.41 RCW or an ambulatory surgical facility defined by RCW
- 13 70.230.010, a registered surgical technologist must first submit
- 14 evidence of any one of the following to the department in a manner
- 15 acceptable to the secretary:
- 16 (1) Successful completion of a nationally and programmatically 17 accredited surgical technology program;
- 18 (2) Successful completion of a surgical technology program 19 offered by the United States armed forces; or
- 20 (3) Performance of surgical technology functions in a hospital or 21 an ambulatory surgical facility for a period of one year in the five 22 years immediately preceding January 1, 2016. A person who has
- 23 performed surgical technology functions in a hospital or an 24 ambulatory surgical facility for a period of one year in the five
- 25 years immediately preceding January 1, 2016, may perform surgical
- 25 years immediately preceding January 1, 2016, may perform surgical
- 26 technology functions at any hospital or ambulatory surgical facility
- 27 after January 1, 2016.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 18.215 29 RCW to read as follows:
- 30 This chapter does not prohibit or affect:
- 31 (1) The practice of an individual licensed, certified, or
- 32 registered under the laws of this state and performing services
- 33 within his or her authorized scope of practice;
- 34 (2) A person performing functions in the discharge of official
- 35 duties on behalf of the United States government, including the armed
- 36 forces, coast guard, public health services, veterans' bureau, or
- 37 bureau of Indian affairs; or

- 1 (3) A person completing the clinical portion of a surgical technology education program.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** A new section is added to chapter 18.215 4 RCW to read as follows:
- 5 A person who does not meet the requirements of this chapter may 6 practice surgical technology in a health care facility if:
- 7 (1) After a diligent and thorough effort has been made, the 8 health care facility is unable to employ a sufficient number of
- 9 persons who meet the requirements of this chapter; and
- 10 (2) The health care facility makes a written record of its
- 11 efforts made pursuant to subsection (1) of this section and retains
- 12 the record at the health care facility.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. A new section is added to chapter 18.215
- 14 RCW to read as follows:
- The department of health may adopt rules necessary to implement
- 16 this act.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** Sections 1 through 5 of this act take
- 18 effect January 1, 2016.
