1            AN ACT Relating to digital copies of public employees' collective  
2 bargaining agreements; adding a new section to chapter 41.56 RCW;  
3 adding a new section to chapter 41.80 RCW; adding a new section to  
4 chapter 41.76 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 41.59 RCW; adding  
5 a new section to chapter 49.39 RCW; adding a new section to chapter  
6 28B.52 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 47.64 RCW; adding a new  
7 section to chapter 49.66 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter  
8 41.58 RCW.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

10            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.**    A new section is added to chapter 41.56  
11 RCW to read as follows:

12            The employer shall submit a digital copy of their collective  
13 bargaining agreement to the commission within thirty days of the  
14 effective date of the collective bargaining agreement.

15            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 2.**    A new section is added to chapter 41.80  
16 RCW to read as follows:

17            The employer shall submit a digital copy of their collective  
18 bargaining agreement to the commission within thirty days of the  
19 effective date of the collective bargaining agreement.

1        NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 3.**    A new section is added to chapter 41.76  
2    RCW to read as follows:

3        The employer shall submit a digital copy of their collective  
4    bargaining agreement to the commission within thirty days of the  
5    effective date of the collective bargaining agreement.

6        NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 4.**    A new section is added to chapter 41.59  
7    RCW to read as follows:

8        The employer shall submit a digital copy of their collective  
9    bargaining agreement to the commission within thirty days of the  
10   effective date of the collective bargaining agreement.

11       NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 5.**    A new section is added to chapter 49.39  
12   RCW to read as follows:

13       The employer shall submit a digital copy of their collective  
14   bargaining agreement to the commission within thirty days of the  
15   effective date of the collective bargaining agreement.

16       NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 6.**    A new section is added to chapter 28B.52  
17   RCW to read as follows:

18       Employers of academic employees under this chapter shall submit a  
19   digital copy of their collective bargaining agreement to the  
20   commission within thirty days of the effective date of the collective  
21   bargaining agreement.

22       NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 7.**    A new section is added to chapter 47.64  
23   RCW to read as follows:

24       The employer shall submit a digital copy of their collective  
25   bargaining agreement to the commission within thirty days of the  
26   effective date of the collective bargaining agreement.

27       NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 8.**    A new section is added to chapter 49.66  
28   RCW to read as follows:

29       The employer shall submit a digital copy of their collective  
30   bargaining agreement to the department within thirty days of the  
31   effective date of the collective bargaining agreement. The department  
32   shall maintain a web site that allows the public to view and download  
33   the collective bargaining agreements submitted by employers pursuant  
34   to this section. The collective bargaining agreements shall be  
35   available in a uniform digital format. Expired collective bargaining

1 agreements shall be available on the web site for up to ten years  
2 following expiration.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 9.** A new section is added to chapter 41.58  
4 RCW to read as follows:

5 The commission shall maintain a web site that allows the public  
6 to view and download the collective bargaining agreements submitted  
7 by employers pursuant to sections 1 through 8 of this act. The  
8 collective bargaining agreements shall be available in a uniform  
9 digital format. Expired collective bargaining agreements shall be  
10 available on the web site for up to ten years following expiration.
