- 1 AN ACT Relating to the 1063 block replacement project; creating
- 2 new sections; making an appropriation; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- Sec. 1. FINDINGS AND INTENT. The legislature finds 4 NEW SECTION. that the 1063 block replacement project has increased in cost from 5 6 its original proposal. About eighty percent of the operating budget impact of the project if reauthorized would be imposed on the 7 transportation budget appropriation for the 8 state patrol. The consideration legislature intends to coordinate the the 9 10 authorization of the new building with the consideration and 11 development of the transportation budget.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The sum of ten million dollars, or as much 12 13 may be necessary, is reappropriated for the fiscal thereof as biennium ending June 30, 2017, from the state building construction 14 15 account -- state to the department of enterprise services for the 16 continued development of the 1063 block replacement project and is 17 subject to provisions of section 1109, chapter 19, Laws of 2013 2nd 18 sp. sess.

1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** ACQUISITION OF PROPERTIES AND FACILITIES THROUGH FINANCIAL CONTRACTS. (1) The following agencies may enter 2 into financial contracts, paid from any funds of an 3 appropriated or nonappropriated, for the purposes indicated and in 4 not more than the principal amounts indicated, plus financing 5 6 expenses and required reserves pursuant to chapter 39.94 RCW. When 7 securing properties under this section, agencies shall use the most economical financial contract option available, including long-term 8 leases, lease-purchase agreements, lease-development with option to 9 purchase agreements, or financial contracts using certificates of 10 11 participation. Expenditures made by an agency for one of the 12 indicated purposes before the issue date of the authorized financial contract and any certificates of participation therein are intended 13 14 to be reimbursed from proceeds of the financial contract and any certificates of participation therein to the extent provided in the 15 16 agency's financing plan approved by the state finance committee.

State agencies may enter into agreements with the department of enterprise services and the state treasurer's office to develop requests to the legislature for acquisition of properties and facilities through financial contracts. The agreements may include charges for services rendered.

- (2) Department of enterprise services: Enter into a financing 22 contract for up to \$69,000,000 plus financing expenses and required 24 reserves pursuant to chapter 39.94 RCW to construct a new office 25 building at 1063 Capitol Way South, Olympia.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. This act is necessary for the immediate 27 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect immediately. 29
