1 AN ACT Relating to certain exclusions from the definition of  
2 worker under industrial insurance statutes; and amending RCW  
3 51.08.181.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 51.08.181 and 2008 c 102 s 5 are each amended to  
6 read as follows:

7 For the purposes of this title, any individual performing  
8 services that require registration under chapter 18.27 RCW or  
9 licensing under chapter 19.28 RCW for remuneration under an  
10 independent contract is not a worker when:

11 (1) The individual has been, and will continue to be, free from  
12 control or direction over the performance of the service, both under  
13 the contract of service and in fact. For the purposes of this  
14 chapter, requirements regarding sequencing, deadlines, or date and  
15 time of entry to a worksite do not constitute control or direction,  
16 nor do reasonable expectations of professional dress, conduct,  
17 demeanor, safety, or any other conditions specified in the agreement  
18 with the owner of the property or a higher tier contractor. This  
19 section does not affect the right of any party to enforce the  
20 agreement;

1 (2) The service is either outside the usual course of business  
2 for which the service is performed, or the service is performed  
3 outside all of the places of business of the enterprise for which the  
4 service is performed, or the individual is responsible, both under  
5 the contract and in fact, for the costs of the principal place of  
6 business from which the service is performed;

7 (3) The individual is customarily engaged in (~~(an independently~~  
8 ~~established))~~ a trade, occupation, profession, or business, of the  
9 same nature as that involved in the contract of service(~~(, or the~~  
10 ~~individual has a principal place of business for the business the~~  
11 ~~individual is conducting that is eligible for a business deduction~~  
12 ~~for federal income tax purposes other than that furnished by the~~  
13 ~~employer for which the business has contracted to furnish services;~~

14 ~~(4) On the effective date of the contract of service, the~~  
15 ~~individual is responsible for filing at the next applicable filing~~  
16 ~~period, both under the contract of service and in fact, a schedule of~~  
17 ~~expenses with the internal revenue service for the type of business~~  
18 ~~the individual is conducting));~~

19 ~~((+5))~~ (4) On the effective date of the contract of service, or  
20 within a reasonable period after the effective date of the contract,  
21 the individual has an active and valid certificate of registration  
22 with the department of revenue, and an active and valid account with  
23 ~~((any other state agencies))~~ the department as required by the  
24 particular case, for the business the individual is conducting for  
25 the payment of all state taxes normally paid by employers and  
26 businesses and has registered for and received a unified business  
27 identifier number from the state of Washington. If checked quarterly  
28 or within a reasonable period before, during, and/or after the  
29 agreement, reliance on department of revenue and department published  
30 information constitutes compliance with this subsection;

31 ~~((+6) On the effective date of the contract of service, the~~  
32 ~~individual is maintaining a separate set of books or records that~~  
33 ~~reflect all items of income and expenses of the business which the~~  
34 ~~individual is conducting;))~~ and

35 ~~((+7))~~ (5) On the effective date of the contract of service, the  
36 individual has a valid contractor registration pursuant to chapter  
37 18.27 RCW or an electrical contractor license pursuant to chapter  
38 19.28 RCW. If checked quarterly or within a reasonable period before,

1 during, and/or after the agreement, reliance on department published  
2 information constitutes compliance with this subsection.
