- AN ACT Relating to peace officers; and adding a new section to
- 2 chapter 9.94A RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9.94A 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Any peace officer has authority to assist the department with 7 the supervisions of offenders.
- 8 (2) If a peace officer has reasonable cause to believe an offender is in violation of the terms of supervision, the peace officer may conduct a search as provided under RCW 9.94A.631, of the offender's person, automobile, or other personal property to search for evidence of the violation. A peace officer may assist a community corrections officer with a search of the offender's residence if requested to do so by the community corrections officer.
- 15 (3) Nothing in this section prevents a peace officer from 16 arresting an offender for any new crime found as a result of the 17 offender's arrest or search authorized by this section.
