1 AN ACT Relating to requiring an HPV immunization report; and
2 adding a new section to chapter 70.290 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 70.290
5 RCW to read as follows:

6 (1) Beginning March 1, 2017, and annually thereafter, the
7 secretary must report to the health care committees of the senate and
8 house of representatives on HPV vaccine utilization. The report must
9 include data from the previous calendar year on the following
10 information:

11 (a) The number of doses of the HPV vaccine delivered to
12 physicians and clinics ordering state-supplied HPV vaccines under
13 this chapter;

14 (b) The number of doses of the HPV vaccine administered, broken
15 down by whether one, two, or three doses of the vaccine have been
16 administered;

17 (c) The age of the person receiving the vaccination;

18 (d) The gender of the person receiving the vaccination; and

19 (e) Whether the clinician has recommended the vaccination to a
20 patient, broken down by age and gender for the patient.

1 (2) The report must include the information outlined in
2 subsection (1) of this section in numbers that apply state-wide and
3 broken down by county. It must also include recommendations for
4 increasing utilization of the vaccine and ways to encourage and
5 increase the number of clinician recommendations for the vaccine.

6 (3) As appropriate, the secretary may use other resources to
7 complete this report such as information provided by the centers for
8 disease control.
