

SB 5714 - DIGEST

Prohibits a state agency or state organization, having jurisdiction over criminal law enforcement or regulatory violations, from purchasing an extraordinary sensing device unless money is expressly appropriated by the legislature for this specific purpose.

Prohibits a local agency, having jurisdiction over criminal law enforcement or regulatory violations, from procuring an extraordinary sensing device without the explicit approval of the governing body of the locality, given for that specific extraordinary sensing device to be used for a specific purpose.

Requires the department of enterprise services to convene a work group to submit a report to the legislature proposing standards for the use of extraordinary sensing devices for regulatory enforcement purposes.
