- On page 3, after line 36, insert the following:
- 2 "The appropriation in this section is subject to the following
- 3 conditions and limitations: Within the amount provided in this
- 4 section, the department shall conduct a pilot program to consist of
- 5 the following activities:
- 6 (1) The department shall produce a fuel tax sticker for display
- 7 on each motor fuel pump from which fuel is sold at retail that
- 8 displays and provides notice of the federal and state fuel tax
- 9 rates. The sticker must display the rate of each tax, in cents per
- 10 gallon, for each type of fuel.
- 11 (2) The department shall provide notice of federal and state
- 12 fuel tax rates, in the form of a fuel tax sticker, with any other
- 13 notice displayed or required by department rule to be displayed on
- 14 motor fuel pumps.
- 15 (3) The department shall distribute fuel tax stickers to all
- 16 individuals who conduct fuel pump inspections, including department
- 17 employees and local government employees. Government employees who
- 18 conduct fuel pump inspections shall display a fuel tax sticker on
- 19 each motor fuel pump or shall verify that such a sticker is being
- 20 displayed at the time of inspection as required by this subsection.
- 21 Fuel tax stickers must:
- 22 (a) Be displayed on each face of the motor fuel pump on which
- 23 the price of the fuel sold from the pump is displayed; and
- (b) Be displayed in a clear, conspicuous, and prominent manner.
- 25 (4) The department shall provide fuel tax stickers by mail to
- 26 fuel pump owners who request them for the face of each motor fuel
- 27 pump for which a sticker is requested.

1 (5) The department shall produce updated fuel tax stickers on an 2 annual basis when one or more fuel tax rates have changed. Fuel tax 3 stickers must be replaced at the time of motor fuel pump inspection 4 if the sticker has been updated with any new fuel tax rates.

<u>EFFECT:</u> Mandates the Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA) implement a two-year pilot program that:

- 1) Produces a sticker for display on motor fuel pumps that provides information on federal and state fuel tax rates;
- 2) Distributes fuel tax stickers to all individuals who conduct motor fuel pump inspections;
- 3) Requires display of fuel tax stickers on motor fuel pumps at the time of inspection by government employees;
- 4) Provides for mailing of fuel tax stickers to motor fuel pump owners who request them; and
- 5) Updates fuel tax stickers on an annual basis when one or more fuel tax rates have changed.

FISCAL IMPACT: No net change to appropriated levels.
