20 (1) The joint legislative audit and review committee shall conduct
21 an analysis of breakfast after the bell programs established in
22 schools in accordance with section 3 of this act. The analysis of the
23 schools establishing breakfast after the bell programs shall include a
24 review of any changes in student:

25 (a) Tardiness and absenteeism;

26 (b) Suspensions;

27 (c) Reported illnesses and visits to nurses' offices;

1 (d) Results on standardized tests; and

2 (e) Graduation rates.

3 (2) The analysis shall also include a review of the outcomes of
4 similar programs or efforts in other states.

5 (3) The office of the superintendent of public instruction and the
6 education and research data center of the office of financial
7 management shall assist in providing any data required to conduct the
8 analysis. The analysis, including any findings and recommendations,
9 must be completed and submitted to the superintendent of public
10 instruction and, in accordance with RCW 43.01.036, the education
11 committees of the house of representatives and the senate by December
12 1, 2025.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 13.** Sections 3, 4, and 7 of this act expire
15 June 30, 2027."

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EFFECT:

(1) Directs the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Committee (JLARC) to conduct an analysis of breakfast after the bell (BAB) programs established in accordance with the underlying legislation.

(2) Delineates provisions to be included with the JLARC analysis and specifies a completion and reporting date of December 1, 2025.

(3) Expires provisions requiring the establishment of BAB programs in qualifying high-needs schools on June 30, 2027.

(4) Expires provisions requiring the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction to provide BAB-related procedures, guidelines, and technical support, and to perform other duties related to BAB programs, on June 30, 2027.

(5) Modifies intent language to align with the JLARC analysis and to correct a grammatical error.

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
