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3 "Sec. 4. RCW 28A.232.020 and 2013 2nd sp.s. c 18 s 503 are each  
4 amended to read as follows:

5 The superintendent of public instruction shall separately  
6 calculate and allocate moneys appropriated under RCW 28A.150.260 to  
7 school districts for each full-time equivalent student enrolled in  
8 an alternative learning experience course. The calculation for non-  
9 career and technical education alternative learning experience  
10 courses shall be based on the estimated statewide annual average  
11 allocation per full-time equivalent student in grades nine through  
12 twelve in general education, excluding small high school  
13 enhancements, and including applicable rules and provisions of the  
14 omnibus appropriations act. The calculation for career and  
15 technical education alternative learning experience courses shall be  
16 based on the estimated statewide annual average allocation per full-  
17 time equivalent student in grades nine through twelve in general  
18 education, including career and technical education program funding  
19 enhancements."
