1 On page 3, line 11, after "age" insert ", except that a person who
2 is under twenty-one years of age and at least eighteen years of age
3 and who is an active duty member of the armed forces of the United
4 States or a member of the national guard or the reserves of the armed
5 forces of the United States is not ineligible for a concealed pistol
6 license under this subsection (1)(c)"

8 On page 8, after line 4, insert the following:

9 "Sec. 3. RCW 9.41.240 and 1994 sp.s. c 7 s 423 are each amended
10 to read as follows:

11 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, and
12 unless an exception under RCW 9.41.042, 9.41.050, or 9.41.060
13 applies, a person at least eighteen years of age, but less than
14 twenty-one years of age, may possess a pistol only:

15 ~~((1))~~ (a) In the person's place of abode;

16 ~~((2))~~ (b) At the person's fixed place of business; or

17 ~~((3))~~ (c) On real property under his or her control.

18 (2) This section does not apply to a person at least eighteen
19 years of age, but less than twenty-one years of age, who is an
20 active duty member of the armed forces of the United States or a
21 member of the national guard or the reserves of the armed forces of
22 the United States."

24 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Provides that active duty members of the United States armed forces or members of the reserves or National Guard who are at least 18 years of age are allowed to possess pistols and eligible to obtain a concealed pistol license.
