1 On page 37, after line 13, insert the following:
2 "(10) Within amounts appropriated in this section, the department
3 must update, or contract with an eligible independent third party to
4 update, the October 2006 report to the state emergency response
5 commission regarding statewide response to chemical, biological,
6 radiological, nuclear, and explosive materials. The updated report
7 must also include an update to appendix A of that report, which
8 addresses the state's current hazardous materials response
9 capabilities and that reviews the emergency response programs of other
10 states. The contract for the updated report must give special emphasis
11 to addressing recent changes to patterns of hazardous material
12 transportation, including crude oil transportation, and the
13 availability of resources to respond to incidents resulting from the
14 transport of hazardous materials. The report must be completed and
15 submitted to the appropriate committees of the legislature by June 30,
16 2018."

EFFECT: Requires the Military Department to update a 2006 hazardous materials report.

FISCAL IMPACT: No net change to appropriated levels.
