- 1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the 2 following:
- 3 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 41.05 4 RCW to read as follows:
- 5 (1) Subject to appropriation, a health plan offered to employees 6 and their covered dependents under this chapter issued or renewed on 7 or after January 1, 2018, must include coverage for hearing 8 instruments. Coverage must include no more than one new hearing 9 instrument every five years and services and supplies such as the 10 initial assessment, fitting, adjustment, and auditory training.
- 11 (2) The hearing instrument must be recommended by a licensed 12 audiologist or hearing aid specialist and dispensed by a licensed 13 audiologist or hearing aid specialist.
- 14 (3) For the purposes of this section, "hearing instrument" and 15 "hearing aid specialist" have the same meaning as defined in RCW 16 18.35.010.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 74.09
 RCW to read as follows:
- (1) The medical assistance coverage offered under this chapter 19 20 issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2018, must include coverage 21 for hearing instruments when medically necessary. Coverage must include no more than one new hearing instrument every five years and 22 23 services and supplies such as the initial assessment, fitting, adjustment, and auditory training. Coverage must include a new 24 hearing instrument sooner than every five years if alterations to the 25 26 existing hearing instrument cannot meet the needs of the patient.
- 27 (2) The hearing instrument must be recommended by a licensed 28 audiologist or hearing aid specialist and dispensed by a licensed 29 audiologist or hearing aid specialist.

- 1 (3) For purposes of this section, "hearing instrument" and 2 "hearing aid specialist" have the same meaning as defined in RCW
- 3 18.35.010.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** If specific funding for the purposes of section 2 of this act, referencing section 2 of this act by bill or
- 6 chapter number and section number, is not provided by June 30, 2017,
- 7 in the omnibus appropriations act, section 2 of this act is null and
- 8 void."
- 9 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Specifies that coverage for hearing instruments for Public Employees' Benefit Board enrollees and Medicaid enrollees is limited to no more than one hearing instrument every five years. Provides an exception to the five year limitation for Medicaid enrollees whose existing hearing instrument cannot be altered to meet their needs.
