1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 28A.345  
4 RCW to read as follows:

5 (1) The Washington state school directors' association must convene  
6 a work group of interested stakeholders to update its model policy and  
7 procedure for interviews and interrogations of students on school  
8 premises in consideration of necessary accommodations for students who:

9 (a) Are homeless, or otherwise, without a legal guardian to notify;

10 (b) Are undocumented;

11 (c) are in foster care, extended foster care, or aged out of foster  
12 care; and

13 (d) Have intellectual or developmental disabilities or are otherwise  
14 unable to make age appropriate decisions when engaging with school  
15 administrators, law enforcement, or other authorities.

16 (2) The Washington state school directors' association must submit  
17 its updated model policy and procedure for interviews and interrogations  
18 of students on school premises to the appropriate committees of the  
19 legislature by December 15, 2018."

EFFECT: Strikes provisions of the underlying bill requiring school districts to adopt a policy and procedure for interviews and interrogations of students on school premises that meets certain requirements. Requires the Washington State School Directors' Association to convene a work group to update its model policy and procedure for interviews and interrogations of students on

school premises in consideration of necessary accommodations for certain students; and to submit the updated model policy and procedures to the appropriate committees of the Legislature by December 15, 2018.
