1 On page 6, after line 30, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 10. RCW 29A.08.140 and 2011 c 10 s 15 are each amended to
3 read as follows:

4 (1) In order to vote in any primary other than a presidential
5 primary, special election, or general election, a person who is not
6 registered to vote in Washington must:

7 (a) Submit a registration application no later than twenty-nine
8 days before the day of the primary, special election, or general
9 election; or

10 (b) Register in person at the county auditor's office in his or
11 her county of residence no later than eight days before the day of
12 the primary, special election, or general election.

13 (2) A person who is already registered to vote in Washington may
14 update his or her registration no later than twenty-nine days before
15 the day of the primary, special election, or general election to be
16 in effect for that primary, special election, or general election. A
17 registered voter who fails to transfer his or her residential address
18 by this deadline may vote according to his or her previous
19 registration address.

20 (3) In order to vote in any presidential primary election, a
21 person who is not registered to vote in Washington must:

22 (a) Submit a registration application no later than twenty-nine
23 days before the day of the election; or

24 (b) Register in person at the county auditor's office, or other
25 location designated by the county auditor, in his or her county of
26 residence no later than 5:00 p.m. on the day of the election."
