1 On page 28, after line 10, insert the following:

2 **"Part VII - Other School Safety Provisions**

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 24.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.50
4 RCW to read as follows:

5 Subject to the availability of funds appropriated for this
6 specific purpose, the state board for community and technical
7 colleges and the Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs
8 must collaborate to:

9 (1) Examine the safety and security needs of community and
10 technical colleges, and report to the appropriate committees of the
11 legislature with recommendations on how to improve the safety and
12 security needs of community and technical colleges; and

13 (2) Determine whether existing law enables community and
14 technical colleges to contract with local law enforcement agencies
15 for law enforcement services:

16 (a) If it is determined that existing law does allow community
17 and technical colleges to contract with local law enforcement
18 agencies for law enforcement services, develop a template contract
19 and accompanying information to assist community and technical
20 colleges in contracting for such services; or

21 (b) If it is determined that existing law does not allow
22 community and technical colleges to contract with local law
23 enforcement agencies for law enforcement services, make
24 recommendations to the legislature on what statutory changes are
25 necessary to allow such action."

26 Renumber the remaining section consecutively and correct any
27 internal references accordingly.

1 On page 1, line 10 of the title, after "rifles;" strike "and
2 generating funds;" and insert "generating funds; and addressing
3 campus safety of community and technical colleges;"

4 On page 1, line 17 of the title, after "28A.310 RCW;" insert
5 "adding a new section to chapter 28B.50 RCW;"

EFFECT: Requires WASPC and the SBCTC to determine whether community and technical colleges can contract with local law enforcement agencies to address campus safety and security needs. The SBCTC and WASPC will facilitate distribution of contracting information or make recommendations to the legislature as necessary after evaluation.
