SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 1679

State of Washington 65th Legislature 2017 Regular Session

By House Appropriations (originally sponsored by Representatives Goodman, Klippert, Pettigrew, Chapman, Hayes, Muri, Hudgins, and Robinson; by request of Department of Corrections)

AN ACT Relating to issuing a two-year identicard for offenders released from prison facilities; amending RCW 46.20.117 and 46.20.117; adding a new section to chapter 72.09 RCW; creating new sections; providing an effective date; and providing an expiration date.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

7 NEW SECTION. The legislature intends to create an Sec. 1. identicard program to assist incarcerated offenders to obtain a 8 9 state-issued identicard to aid and prepare offenders for release from prison and reentry into the community. The legislature finds that 10 11 each step that assists individuals being released from prisons helps incarcerated offenders avoid predictable conditions that lead to 12 future recidivism. In accordance with executive order 16-05 building 13 14 safe and strong communities through successful reentry, this act intends to ensure that offenders released from state prisons have 15 16 adequate identification in order to increase public safety and reduce 17 recidivism.

18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 72.09

19 RCW to read as follows:

- 1 (1) The department, working in conjunction with the department of 2 licensing, shall create and implement an identicard program to 3 provide offenders released within Washington state a state-issued 4 identicard pursuant to RCW 46.20.117.
 - (2) The department may determine eligibility for an original, renewal, or replacement identicard pursuant to this section.

- (3) The department may seek reimbursement for the cost of the identicard issued to offenders pursuant to this section. The department may deduct the cost of the identicard from either the offender's mandatory savings account; or from funds that have been received on the offender's behalf specifically for this purpose.
- 12 **Sec. 3.** RCW 46.20.117 and 2012 c 80 s 6 are each amended to read 13 as follows:
- 14 (1) **Issuance**. The department shall issue an identicard, 15 containing a picture, if the applicant:
 - (a)(i) Does not hold a valid Washington driver's license;
- 17 $((\frac{b}{b}))$ (ii) Proves his or her identity as required by RCW 18 46.20.035; and
 - (((c))) (iii) Pays the required fee. Except as provided in (b) of this subsection or subsection (5) of this section, the fee is ((forty-five dollars from October 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, and)) fifty-four dollars ((after June 30, 2013)), unless an applicant is a recipient of continuing public assistance grants under Title 74 RCW, who is referred in writing by the secretary of social and health services. For those persons the fee must be the actual cost of production of the identicard; or
- 27 <u>(b) Is eligible for issuance of an identicard under section 2 of</u> 28 this act.
- (i) A valid identification card issued by the department of corrections may serve as sufficient proof of identity and residency for an applicant under this subsection (1)(b);
- (ii) An identicard issued under this subsection (1)(b) must
 expire two years from the first anniversary of the offender's
 birthdate after issuance; and
- 35 <u>(iii) The department may charge the department of corrections a</u>
 36 <u>fee</u> of eighteen dollars for an identicard issued under this
 37 <u>subsection (1)(b)</u>.
 - (2) **Design and term**. The identicard must:

- 1 (a) Be distinctly designed so that it will not be confused with 2 the official driver's license; and
- 3 (b) Except as provided in subsection <u>(1)(b) or</u> (5) of this 4 section, expire on the sixth anniversary of the applicant's birthdate 5 after issuance.
- 6 (3) **Renewal**. An application for identicard renewal may be 7 submitted by means of:
 - (a) Personal appearance before the department; or

- 9 (b) Mail or electronic commerce, if permitted by rule of the 10 department and if the applicant did not renew his or her identicard 11 by mail or by electronic commerce when it last expired.
- 12 An identicard may not be renewed by mail or by electronic 13 commerce unless the renewal issued by the department includes a 14 photograph of the identicard holder.
- 15 (4) **Cancellation**. The department may cancel an identicard if the 16 holder of the identicard used the card or allowed others to use the 17 card in violation of RCW 46.20.0921.
- (5) Alternative issuance/renewal/extension. The department may 18 issue or renew an identicard for a period other than five years from 19 October 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, or six years after June 30, 2013, 20 21 or may extend by mail or electronic commerce an identicard that has already been issued, in order to evenly distribute, as nearly as 22 possible, the yearly renewal rate of identicard holders. The fee for 23 24 an identicard issued or renewed for a period other than five years 25 from October 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, or six years after June 30, 26 2013, or that has been extended by mail or electronic commerce, is nine dollars for each year that the identicard is issued, renewed, or 27 extended. The department may adopt any rules as are necessary to 28 29 carry out this subsection.
- 30 **Sec. 4.** RCW 46.20.117 and 2014 c 185 s 2 are each amended to 31 read as follows:
- 32 (1) **Issuance**. The department shall issue an identicard, 33 containing a picture, if the applicant:
- 34 (a)(i) Does not hold a valid Washington driver's license;
- $((\frac{b}{b}))$ (ii) Proves his or her identity as required by RCW 46.20.035; and
- (((c))) <u>(iii)</u> Pays the required fee. Except as provided in <u>(b) of</u>
 this subsection or subsection (5) of this section, the fee is
 ((forty-five dollars from October 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, and))

- 1 fifty-four dollars ((after June 30, 2013)), unless an applicant is a

- 6 (b) Is eligible for issuance of an identicard under section 2 of this act.
- 8 <u>(i) A valid identification card issued by the department of</u>
 9 <u>corrections may serve as sufficient proof of identity and residency</u>
 10 <u>for an applicant under this subsection (1)(b);</u>
- (ii) An identicard issued under this subsection (1)(b) must expire two years from the first anniversary of the offender's birthdate after issuance; and
- 14 <u>(iii) The department may charge the department of corrections a</u>
 15 <u>fee of eighteen dollars for an identicard issued under this</u>
 16 subsection (1)(b).
 - (2)(a) **Design and term**. The identicard must:
- 18 (i) Be distinctly designed so that it will not be confused with 19 the official driver's license; and
- 20 (ii) Except as provided in subsection <u>(1)(b) or</u> (5) of this 21 section, expire on the sixth anniversary of the applicant's birthdate 22 after issuance.
- 23 (b) The identicard may include the person's status as a veteran, 24 consistent with RCW 46.20.161(2).
 - (3) **Renewal**. An application for identicard renewal may be submitted by means of:
 - (a) Personal appearance before the department; or
- (b) Mail or electronic commerce, if permitted by rule of the department and if the applicant did not renew his or her identicard by mail or by electronic commerce when it last expired.
- An identicard may not be renewed by mail or by electronic commerce unless the renewal issued by the department includes a photograph of the identicard holder.
 - (4) **Cancellation**. The department may cancel an identicard if the holder of the identicard used the card or allowed others to use the card in violation of RCW 46.20.0921.
 - (5) Alternative issuance/renewal/extension. The department may issue or renew an identicard for a period other than five years from October 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, or six years after June 30, 2013, or may extend by mail or electronic commerce an identicard that has

- 1 already been issued, in order to evenly distribute, as nearly as
- 2 possible, the yearly renewal rate of identicard holders. The fee for
- 3 an identicard issued or renewed for a period other than five years
- 4 from October 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, or six years after June 30,
- 5 2013, or that has been extended by mail or electronic commerce, is
- 6 nine dollars for each year that the identicard is issued, renewed, or
- 7 extended. The department may adopt any rules as are necessary to
- 8 carry out this subsection.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** The department of corrections and the
- 10 department of licensing may enter into a memorandum of understanding
- 11 to meet the requirements of this act, and have discretion to
- 12 implement this act over a period of time not to exceed twelve months
- 13 from the effective date of this section.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** Section 4 of this act takes effect August
- 15 30, 2017.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** Section 3 of this act expires August 30,
- 17 2017.
