1 AN ACT Relating to improving the community economic
2 revitalization board program; and amending RCW 43.160.900.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.160.900 and 2014 c 112 s 109 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 (1) The community economic revitalization board (~~shall~~) must
7 conduct biennial outcome-based evaluations of the financial
8 assistance provided under this chapter. The evaluations (~~shall~~)
9 must include information on the number of applications for community
10 economic revitalization board assistance; the number and types of
11 projects approved; the grant or loan amount awarded each project; the
12 projected number of jobs created or retained by each project; the
13 actual number and cost of jobs created or retained by each project;
14 the wages and health benefits associated with the jobs; the amount of
15 state funds and total capital invested in projects; the number and
16 types of businesses assisted by funded projects; the location of
17 funded projects; the transportation infrastructure available for
18 completed projects; the local match and local participation obtained;
19 the number of delinquent loans; and the number of project
20 terminations. The evaluations may also include additional performance
21 measures and recommendations for programmatic changes.

1 (2) The evaluation must be presented to the governor and
2 appropriate committees of the legislature by December 31st of each
3 even-numbered year. The initial evaluation must be submitted by
4 December 31, 2010.

5 (3) The community economic revitalization board must utilize the
6 outcome-based evaluation reports required in this section to develop
7 a strategic plan for the funding appropriated for financing public
8 facilities under this chapter. The strategic plan should incorporate
9 the data collected in the evaluation reports to determine the most
10 effective ways of meeting the statutory goals set out in this
11 chapter. By December 31, 2017, and in compliance with RCW 43.01.036,
12 the board must submit the strategic plan to the legislature.

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
