1 AN ACT Relating to establishing permissible methods of parking a
2 motorcycle; and amending RCW 46.61.575.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.61.575 and 1977 ex.s. c 151 s 41 are each amended
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, every vehicle
7 stopped or parked upon a two-way roadway shall be so stopped or
8 parked with the right-hand wheels parallel to and within twelve
9 inches of the right-hand curb or as close as practicable to the right
10 edge of the right-hand shoulder.

11 (2) Except when otherwise provided by local ordinance, every
12 vehicle other than a motorcycle stopped or parked upon a one-way
13 roadway shall be so stopped or parked parallel to the curb or edge of
14 the roadway, in the direction of authorized traffic movement, with
15 its right-hand wheels within twelve inches of the right-hand curb or
16 as close as practicable to the right edge of the right-hand shoulder,
17 or with its left-hand wheels within twelve inches of the left-hand
18 curb or as close as practicable to the left edge of the left-hand
19 shoulder.

20 (3)(a) Every motorcycle stopped or parked on a two-way or one-way
21 highway shall be so stopped or parked parallel or at an angle to the

1 curb or edge of the highway with at least one wheel or fender within
2 twelve inches of the curb nearest to which the motorcycle is parked
3 or as close as practicable to the edge of the shoulder nearest to
4 which the motorcycle is parked. A motorcycle may not be parked in
5 such a manner that it extends into the roadway.

6 (b) More than one motorcycle may occupy a parking space, provided
7 that the parked motorcycles occupying the parking space do not exceed
8 the boundaries of that parking space.

9 (4) Local authorities may by ordinance or resolution permit angle
10 parking on any roadway, except that angle parking shall not be
11 permitted on any federal-aid or state highway unless the secretary of
12 transportation has determined by order that the roadway is of
13 sufficient width to permit angle parking without interfering with the
14 free movement of traffic. The angle parking of motorcycles, which is
15 governed under subsection (3) of this section, is not subject to this
16 determination by the secretary of transportation.

17 ((+4)) (5) The secretary with respect to highways under his or
18 her jurisdiction may place official traffic control devices
19 prohibiting, limiting, or restricting the stopping, standing, or
20 parking of vehicles on any highway where the secretary has determined
21 by order, such stopping, standing, or parking is dangerous to those
22 using the highway or where the stopping, standing, or parking of
23 vehicles would unduly interfere with the free movement of traffic
24 thereon. No person shall stop, stand, or park any vehicle in
25 violation of the restrictions indicated by such devices.
