1 AN ACT Relating to quick title service fees; amending RCW
2 46.17.160, 46.68.025, 88.02.640, 88.02.640, and 88.02.640; providing
3 effective dates; and providing expiration dates.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.17.160 and 2011 c 326 s 2 are each amended to
6 read as follows:

7 Before accepting an application for a quick title of a vehicle
8 under RCW 46.12.555, the department, participating county auditor or
9 other agent, or subagent appointed by the director shall require the
10 applicant to pay a (~~fifty~~) twenty-five dollar quick title service
11 fee in addition to any other fees and taxes required by law. The
12 quick title service fee must be distributed under RCW 46.68.025.

13 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.68.025 and 2015 2nd sp.s. c 1 s 1 are each
14 amended to read as follows:

15 (1) The quick title service fee imposed under RCW 46.17.160 must
16 be distributed as follows:

17 (a) If the fee is paid to the director, the fee must be deposited
18 to the motor vehicle fund established under RCW 46.68.070.

19 (b) If the fee is paid to the participating county auditor or
20 other agent appointed by the director, (~~twenty-five dollars~~) the

1 ~~fee~~ must be (~~deposited to the motor vehicle fund established under~~
 2 ~~RCW 46.68.070. The remainder must be~~) retained by the county
 3 treasurer in the same manner as other fees collected by the county
 4 auditor.

5 (c) If the fee is paid to a subagent appointed by the director,
 6 (~~twenty five dollars must be deposited to the motor vehicle fund~~
 7 ~~established under RCW 46.68.070. The remaining twenty five dollars~~
 8 ~~must be distributed as follows:~~) twelve dollars and fifty cents must
 9 be retained by the county treasurer in the same manner as other fees
 10 collected by the county auditor and twelve dollars and fifty cents
 11 must be retained by the subagent.

12 (2) For the purposes of this section, "quick title" has the same
 13 meaning as in RCW 46.12.555.

11 registration fees at the time application for registration is made.

12 (3) The derelict vessel and invasive species removal fee required
13 in subsection (1) of this section is five dollars and must be
14 distributed as follows:

15 (a) Two dollars must be deposited in the aquatic invasive species
16 management account created in RCW 77.135.200;

17 (b) One dollar must be deposited into the aquatic algae control
18 account created in RCW 43.21A.667; and

19 (c) Two dollars must be deposited in the derelict vessel removal
20 account created in RCW 79.100.100.

21 (4) In addition to other fees required in this section, an annual
22 derelict vessel removal surcharge of one dollar must be charged with
23 each vessel registration. The surcharge is to address the significant
24 backlog of derelict vessels accumulated in Washington waters that
25 pose a threat to the health and safety of the people and to the
26 environment and must be deposited into the derelict vessel removal
27 account created in RCW 79.100.100.

28 (5)(a) The amount of the nonresident vessel permit fee is:

29 (i) For a vessel owned by a nonresident natural person, twenty-
30 five dollars; and

31 (ii) For a nonresident vessel owner that is not a natural person,
32 the fee is equal to:

33 (A) Twenty-five dollars per foot for vessels between thirty and
34 ninety-nine feet in length;

35 (B) Thirty dollars per foot for vessels between one hundred and
36 one hundred twenty feet in length; and

37 (C) Thirty-seven dollars and fifty cents per foot for vessels
38 between one hundred twenty-one and one hundred sixty-four feet in

1 length. The fee must be multiplied by the extreme length of the
2 vessel in feet, rounded up to the nearest whole foot.

3 (b) The fee must be paid by the vessel owner to the department.
4 Any moneys remaining from the fee after the payment of costs to
5 administer the permit must be allocated to counties by the state
6 treasurer for approved boating safety programs under RCW 88.02.650.

7 (c) A nonresident vessel owner that is not a natural person may
8 not obtain more than two nonresident vessel permits under RCW
9 88.02.620 within any thirty-six month period.

10 (6) The thirty dollar vessel visitor permit fee must be
11 distributed as follows:

12 (a) Five dollars must be deposited in the derelict vessel removal
13 account created in RCW 79.100.100;

14 (b) The department may keep an amount to cover costs for
15 providing the vessel visitor permit;

16 (c) Any moneys remaining must be allocated to counties by the
17 state treasurer for approved boating safety programs under RCW
18 88.02.650; and

19 (d) Any fees required for licensing agents under RCW 46.17.005
20 are in addition to any other fee or tax due for the titling and
21 registration of vessels.

22 (7)(a) The (~~fifty~~) twenty-five dollar quick title service fee
23 must be distributed as follows:

24 (i) If the fee is paid to the director, the fee must be deposited
25 to the general fund.

26 (ii) If the fee is paid to the participating county auditor or
27 other agent appointed by the director, (~~twenty-five dollars~~) the

29 retained by the county treasurer in the same manner as other fees

 2 appointed by the director shall charge the service fee under
 3 subsection (1)(m) of this section beginning January 1, 2016.

6 distributed as follows:

7 (a) Two dollars must be deposited in the aquatic invasive species
8 management account created in RCW 77.135.200;

9 (b) One dollar must be deposited into the aquatic algae control
10 account created in RCW 43.21A.667; and

11 (c) Two dollars must be deposited in the derelict vessel removal
12 account created in RCW 79.100.100.

13 (4) In addition to other fees required in this section, an annual
14 derelict vessel removal surcharge of one dollar must be charged with
15 each vessel registration. The surcharge is to address the significant
16 backlog of derelict vessels accumulated in Washington waters that

26 ninety-nine feet in length;

27 (B) Thirty dollars per foot for vessels between one hundred and
28 one hundred twenty feet in length; and

29 (C) Thirty-seven dollars and fifty cents per foot for vessels
30 between one hundred twenty-one and one hundred sixty-four feet in
31 length. The fee must be multiplied by the extreme length of the
32 vessel in feet, rounded up to the nearest whole foot.

33 (b) The fee must be paid by the vessel owner to the department.
34 Any moneys remaining from the fee after the payment of costs to
35 administer the permit must be allocated to counties by the state
36 treasurer for approved boating safety programs under RCW 88.02.650.

37 (c) A nonresident vessel owner that is not a natural person may
38 not obtain more than two nonresident vessel permits under RCW
39 88.02.620 within any thirty-six month period.

1 (6) The thirty dollar vessel visitor permit fee must be
2 distributed as follows:

3 (a) Five dollars must be deposited in the derelict vessel removal
4 account created in RCW 79.100.100;

5 (b) The department may keep an amount to cover costs for
6 providing the vessel visitor permit;

7 (c) Any moneys remaining must be allocated to counties by the
8 state treasurer for approved boating safety programs under RCW
9 88.02.650; and

10 (d) Any fees required for licensing agents under RCW 46.17.005
11 are in addition to any other fee or tax due for the titling and
12 registration of vessels.

13 (7)(a) The (~~fifty~~) twenty-five dollar quick title service fee

16 (6) The thirty dollar vessel visitor permit fee must be
17 distributed as follows:

18 (a) Five dollars must be deposited in the derelict vessel removal
19 account created in RCW 79.100.100;

20 (b) The department may keep an amount to cover costs for
21 providing the vessel visitor permit;

22 (c) Any moneys remaining must be allocated to counties by the
23 state treasurer for approved boating safety programs under RCW
24 88.02.650; and

25 (d) Any fees required for licensing agents under RCW 46.17.005
26 are in addition to any other fee or tax due for the titling and
27 registration of vessels.

28 (7)(a) The (~~fifty~~) twenty-five dollar quick title service fee
29 must be distributed as follows:

30 (i) If the fee is paid to the director, the fee must be deposited
31 to the general fund.

32 (ii) If the fee is paid to the participating county auditor or
33 other agent appointed by the director, (~~twenty-five dollars~~) the
34 fee must be (~~deposited to the general fund. The remainder must be~~)
35 retained by the county treasurer in the same manner as other fees
36 collected by the county auditor.

37 (iii) If the fee is paid to a subagent appointed by the director,
38 (~~twenty-five dollars must be deposited to the general fund. The~~
39 ~~remaining twenty-five dollars must be distributed as follows:~~)
40 twelve dollars and fifty cents must be retained by the county

1 treasurer in the same manner as other fees collected by the county
2 auditor and twelve dollars and fifty cents must be retained by the
3 subagent.

4 (b) For the purposes of this subsection, "quick title" has the
5 same meaning as in RCW 88.02.540.

6 (8) The department, county auditor or other agent, or subagent
7 appointed by the director shall charge the service fee under
8 subsection (1)(m) of this section beginning January 1, 2016.

9 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 6.** Section 3 of this act expires July 1,
10 2019.

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7.** Section 4 of this act takes effect July 1,
12 2019.

13 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 8.** Section 4 of this act expires January 1,
14 2026.

15 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 9.** Section 5 of this act takes effect January
16 1, 2026.

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
