- 1 AN ACT Relating to fire protection district tax levies; and 2 amending RCW 52.16.160.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 52.16.160 and 2002 c 84 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- Notwithstanding the limitation of dollar rates contained in RCW 52.16.130, and in addition to any levy for the payment of the
- 8 principal and interest of any outstanding general obligation bonds
- 9 and in addition to any levy authorized by RCW 52.16.130, 52.16.140 or
- 10 any other statute, the board of fire commissioners of any fire
- 11 protection district within such county((, which fire protection
- 12 district has at least one full-time, paid employee, or contracts with
- 13 another municipal corporation for the services of at least one full-
- 14 time, paid employee,)) is hereby authorized to levy each year an ad
- 15 valorem tax on all taxable property within such district of not to
- 16 exceed fifty cents per thousand dollars of assessed value, which levy
- 17 may be made only if it will not affect dollar rates which other
- 18 taxing districts may lawfully claim nor cause the combined levies to
- 19 exceed the constitutional and/or statutory limitations.
