1 AN ACT Relating to reimbursement for substitute teachers
2 participating in activities of the Washington state professional
3 educator standards board to carry out its powers and duties; and
4 amending RCW 28A.300.035.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28A.300.035 and 1994 c 113 s 1 are each amended to
7 read as follows:

8 If the superintendent of public instruction, the Washington
9 professional educator standards board, or the state board of
10 education, in carrying out their powers and duties under Title 28A
11 RCW, request the service of any certificated or classified employee
12 of a school district upon any committee formed for the purpose of
13 furthering education within the state, or within any school district
14 therein, and such service would result in a need for a school
15 district to employ a substitute for such certificated or classified
16 employee during such service, payment for such a substitute may be
17 made by the superintendent of public instruction from funds
18 appropriated by the legislature for the current use of the common
19 schools and such payments shall be construed as amounts needed for
20 state support to the common schools under RCW 28A.150.380. If such
21 substitute is paid by the superintendent of public instruction, no

1 deduction shall be made from the salary of the certificated or
2 classified employee. In no event shall a school district deduct from
3 the salary of a certificated or classified employee serving on such
4 committee more than the amount paid the substitute employed by the
5 district.
