- 7 its rules surrounding access to high occupancy vehicle lanes. This
- 8 process must consider the benefits and impacts of allowing vehicles
- 9 that deliver or collect blood, tissue, or blood components for a
- 10 blood-collecting or distributing establishment regulated under
- 11 chapter 70.335 RCW into the high occupancy vehicle lanes.
- 12 (2) By January 1, 2019, the department of transportation shall
- 13 report progress of the public rule reexamination process in
- 14 subsection (1) of this section to the transportation committees of
- 15 the legislature with sufficient time for review before the conclusion
- 16 of the process.
- 17 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. This act expires August 1, 2019.
