1 AN ACT Relating to residential custody services for tribal youth;  
2 and adding a new section to chapter 72.05 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 72.05  
5 RCW to read as follows:

6 (1) The department may provide residential custody services in a  
7 state juvenile rehabilitation facility to youth adjudicated and  
8 sentenced by a court of any federally recognized Indian tribe located  
9 within the state of Washington, pursuant to a contract between the  
10 department and the tribe that is entered into in compliance with the  
11 interlocal cooperation act, chapter 39.34 RCW.

12 (2) As used in this section:

13 (a) "Residential custody services" means a comprehensive program  
14 established pursuant to RCW 72.05.130 for the custody, care,  
15 education, treatment, instruction, guidance, control, and  
16 rehabilitation of youth committed to a state juvenile rehabilitation  
17 facility.

18 (b) "State juvenile rehabilitation facility" means an institution  
19 as defined in RCW 13.40.020(13), a community facility as defined in

1 RCW 72.05.020(1), or other juvenile rehabilitation facility operated  
2 by the department.
