1 AN ACT Relating to creating a special license plate to support
2 the maintenance and improvements of Washington state parks;
3 reenacting and amending RCW 46.18.200, 46.17.220, and 46.68.425;
4 adding a new section to chapter 46.04 RCW; and providing an effective
5 date.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

7 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.18.200 and 2017 c 25 s 1 and 2017 c 11 s 2 are
8 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

9 (1) Special license plate series reviewed and approved by the
10 department:

11 (a) May be issued in lieu of standard issue or personalized
12 license plates for vehicles required to display one and two license
13 plates unless otherwise specified;

14 (b) Must be issued under terms and conditions established by the
15 department;

16 (c) Must not be issued for vehicles registered under chapter
17 46.87 RCW; and

18 (d) Must display a symbol or artwork approved by the department.

19 (2) The department approves and shall issue the following special
20 license plates:

28		Washington state.

29 (3) Applicants for initial and renewal professional firefighters
30 and paramedics special license plates must show proof of eligibility
31 by providing a certificate of current membership from the Washington
32 state council of firefighters.

33 (4) Applicants for initial volunteer firefighters special license
34 plates must (a) have been a volunteer firefighter for at least ten
35 years or be a volunteer firefighter for one or more years and (b)
36 have documentation of service from the district of the appropriate
37 fire service. If the volunteer firefighter leaves firefighting
38 service before ten years of service have been completed, the

1 volunteer firefighter shall surrender the license plates to the
 2 department on the registration renewal date. If the volunteer
 3 firefighter stays in service for at least ten years and then leaves,
 4 the license plate may be retained by the former volunteer firefighter
 5 and as long as the license plate is retained for use the person will
 6 continue to pay the future registration renewals. A qualifying
 7 volunteer firefighter may have no more than one set of license plates
 8 per vehicle, and a maximum of two sets per applicant, for their
 9 personal vehicles. If the volunteer firefighter is convicted of a
 10 violation of RCW 46.61.502 or a felony, the license plates must be
 11 surrendered upon conviction.

12 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.17.220 and 2017 c 25 s 2 and 2017 c 11 s 3 are
 13 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

14 (1) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon
 15 application for a vehicle registration in chapter 46.16A RCW, the
 16 holder of a special license plate shall pay the appropriate special
 17 license plate fee as listed in this section.

7 (2) After deducting administration and collection expenses for
8 the sale of baseball stadium license plates, the remaining proceeds
9 must be distributed to a county for the purpose of paying the
10 principal and interest payments on bonds issued by the county to
11 construct a baseball stadium, as defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including
12 reasonably necessary preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being
13 collected under RCW 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer
14 shall credit the funds to the state general fund.

15 **Sec. 3.** RCW 46.68.425 and 2016 c 31 s 3 and 2016 c 30 s 4 are
16 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

- 17 (1) The department shall:
- 18 (a) Collect special license plate fees established under RCW
19 46.17.220;
- 20 (b) Deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars for initial
21 issue and two dollars for renewal issue for administration and
22 collection expenses incurred by it; and
- 23 (c) Remit the remaining proceeds to the custody of the state
24 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report.

25 (2) The state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor
26 vehicle fund until the department determines that the state has been
27 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the special license plate.
28 Upon determination by the department that the state has been
29 reimbursed, the state treasurer shall credit the remaining special
30 license plate fees to the following accounts by special license plate
31 type:

7 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 46.04
8 RCW to read as follows:
9 "Sasquatch license plates" means license plates issued under RCW
10 46.18.200 that displays a symbol or artwork recognizing the cultural
11 significance of Sasquatch in Washington history and folklore.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** This act takes effect January 1, 2019.
