- 1 AN ACT Relating to noncompetition agreements; and adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 49.44 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 49.44 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Except as provided under subsection (2) of this section, any
 7 contract that restrains a person from engaging in a lawful
 8 profession, trade, or business of any kind is against public policy
 9 and is void and unenforceable to the extent that it restrains a
 10 person from engaging in a lawful profession, trade, or business.
- 11 (2) The following persons may agree to refrain from carrying on a 12 similar business within a specific geographic area:
- 13 (a)(i) A person who sells:
- 14 (A) All or substantially all of his or her operating assets of a business entity;
- 16 (B) All or substantially all of his or her operating assets of a 17 division or a subsidiary of a business entity; or
- 18 (C) All of the ownership interest of any subsidiary of a business 19 entity.
- 20 (ii) However, if the buyer does not operate a like business in 21 the specified geographic area, the agreement is void.

(b) Any partner who disassociates from a partnership or who is a partner at the time the partnership is dissolved. However, if no other member of the partnership continues to operate a like business in the specified geographic area, the agreement is void.

(c) Any member whose interest in a limited liability company is terminated. However, if no other member of the limited liability company carries on a like business in the specified geographic area, the agreement is void.
