- 1 AN ACT Relating to expanding the access to baby and child
- 2 dentistry program to serve children with disabilities; and adding a
- 3 new section to chapter 74.09 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 74.09 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The authority shall expand the access to baby and child
- 8 dentistry program to include children with disabilities as eligible
- 9 clients.
- 10 (2) Once enrolled in the program, eligible children with 11 disabilities must be covered until their thirteenth birthday.
- 12 (3) Children with disabilities enrolled in the program shall
- receive all services and benefits received by program clients.

  (4) The authority shall pay enhanced fees for program services
- provided to children with disabilities enrolled in the program to
- 16 dentists certified to provide program services to children with
- 17 disabilities. To receive certification to provide program services to
- 18 children with disabilities, a dentist must:
- 19 (a) Be licensed to practice dentistry under chapter 18.32 RCW;

- 1 (b) Complete a course on treating children with disabilities as 2 defined by the authority in rule.
  - (5) For purposes of this section:

- (a) "Children with disabilities" means all individuals under the 4 age of thirteen with a disability attributable to intellectual 5 6 disability, cerebral palsy, epilepsy, autism, or another neurological condition closely related to an intellectual disability or that 7 requires treatment similar to that required for persons with 8 intellectual disabilities, which has continued or can be expected to 9 continue indefinitely, and which constitutes a substantial limitation 10 11 to such individual, who are eligible for one of the following medical 12 assistance programs:
- (i) Categorically needy program;
- 14 (ii) Limited casualty program-medically needy program;
- 15 (iii) Children's health program; or
- 16 (iv) State children's health insurance program.
- 17 (b) "Program" means the access to baby and child dentistry 18 program as established by WAC 182-535-1245 or successor rule.
