- 1 WHEREAS, The Washington state commercial fishing fleet begins 2 leaving in March for the Pacific and Alaskan waters, and the Blessing 3 of the Fleet occurred at Fisherman's Terminal in Ballard on March 12,

- WHEREAS, This is the 33rd year that the Blessing of the Fleet will occur in Blaine Harbor, and this year it will be presented at Blaine Boating Center on May 7, 2017; and
- 8 WHEREAS, This is the 41st year that the Blessing of the Fleet 9 will occur in Bellingham, and this year it will be presented at 10 Zuanich Point Park in Squalicum Harbor in May 2017; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The Washington state commercial fishing fleet is one of 12 the world's largest distant water fleets; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The commercial fishing industry directly and indirectly 14 employs thousands of people and is one of the largest industries in 15 Washington State, the annual harvest contributes significantly to the 16 Washington State economy; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The life of a fisher is fraught with danger and hardship 18 that most people will never face, and courage is required for anyone 19 who chooses to work on the sea, as fishers must brave the elements in 20 order to harvest the ocean's resources; and
- 21 WHEREAS, The men and women who work on fishing boats, often in 22 dangerous circumstances, deserve our admiration, thanks, and, when 23 tragedy strikes, our remembrance; and
