- 1 WHEREAS, The Senate adopted permanent rules for the 2017-2019
- 2 biennium under Senate Resolution 8602, as amended by Senate
- 3 Resolution 8651; and
- WHEREAS, The notice requirements set forth in Senate Rule 35 have
- 5 been satisfied;
- 6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That Rules 62, 64, and 67 are
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 "Rule 62. Every bill shall be read on three separate days unless
- 9 the senate deems it expedient to suspend this rule. ((Except for
- 10 bills that raise taxes as provided in Rule 64,)) On and after the
- 11 tenth day preceding adjournment sine die of any session, or three
- 12 days prior to any cut-off date for consideration of bills, as
- 13 determined pursuant to Article 2, Section 12 of the Constitution or
- 14 concurrent resolution, or during any special session of the
- 15 legislature, this rule may be suspended by a majority vote. (See also
- 16 Rule 59 and Rule 64).
- 17 Rule 64. Upon second reading, the bill shall be read section by
- 18 section, in full, and be subject to amendment.
- 19 Any member may, if sustained by three members, remove a bill from
- 20 the consent calendar as constituted by the committee on rules. A bill
- 21 removed from the consent calendar shall take its place as the last

- 1 bill in the order of consideration of bills on the second reading
- 2 calendar.
- 3 No amendment shall be considered by the senate until it shall
- 4 have been sent to the secretary's desk in writing and read by the
- 5 secretary.
- 6 All amendments adopted on the second reading shall then be
- 7 securely fastened to the original bill.
- 8 All amendments rejected by the senate shall be spread upon the
- 9 journal, and the journal shall show the disposition of all
- 10 amendments.
- When no further amendments shall be offered, the president shall
- 12 declare the bill has passed its second reading, and shall be referred
- 13 to the committee on rules for third reading((: Provided, That any
- 14 bill that raises taxes requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of
- 15 the senators elected or appointed to advance to third reading, unless
- 16 the bill contains a referendum clause.
- 17 "Raises taxes" means increasing state tax revenue deposited in
- 18 any fund, budget, or account)).
- 19 Rule 67. When there is a disagreement between the senate and
- 20 house on a measure before the senate, the senate may act upon the
- 21 measure with the following motions which have priority in the
- 22 following order:
- 23 To concur
- 24 To non-concur
- 25 To recede
- 26 To insist
- 27 To adhere
- These motions are in order as to any single amendment or to a
- 29 series of amendments. (See Reed's Rules 247 through 254.)
- A senate bill, passed by the house with amendment or amendments
- 31 which shall change the scope and object of the bill, upon being
- 32 received in the senate, shall be referred to an appropriate committee
- 33 and shall take the same course as for original bills, unless a motion
- 34 to ask the house to recede, to insist or to adhere is made prior to
- 35 the measure being referred to committee.
