1 WHEREAS, Excellence in education is vital to the success of our
2 state and nation and in the great state of Washington we seek the
3 betterment of our population and look to provide each child and
4 adolescent with a good education; and

5 WHEREAS, Education develops the intellect through lessons in
6 literacy, math, and science, thereby preparing students for the
7 responsibilities and opportunities of the future; and

8 WHEREAS, The character of our young people is strengthened by
9 lessons in courage and compassion and serving a cause greater than
10 one's self. By encouraging a spirit of service in our children, we
11 create a more optimistic future for them and our state; and

12 WHEREAS, One shining example for all people of what education
13 ought to be was provided by the Rebbe, Rabbi Menachem Schneerson, a
14 global spiritual leader who dedicated his life to the betterment of
15 mankind. A tireless advocate for youth around the world, the Rebbe
16 emphasized the importance of education and good character and
17 instilled hope for a brighter future into the lives of countless
18 people in the United States and across the globe; and

19 WHEREAS, As taught by Rabbi Schneerson, education should not be
20 limited to the acquisition of knowledge and preparation for a career
21 but for the betterment of society as a whole. The educational system
22 must pay more attention to building character and emphasizing moral
23 and ethical values, which are part of society's foundation; and

1 WHEREAS, In recognition of the Rebbe's outstanding and
2 lasting contributions toward improvements in education, ethics,
3 morality, and acts of charity, he has been awarded the
4 Congressional Gold Medal and the United States Congress has
5 established his birth date as a national day to raise awareness
6 and improve the education of our children; and

8 paid recognition to the Rebbe's vision each year on that day by
9 proclaiming it "Education and Sharing Day U.S.A."; and

10 WHEREAS, The President has proclaimed Tuesday, March 27,
