- 17 (B) Local enrichment levies collected by the district in the 2020
- 18 calendar year; and

- 21 (vi) "Number F" is the sum of the following divided by the

- 26 apportionment allocations redirected by the superintendent to the
- 27 special education program;

EFFECT: Requires the superintendent of public instruction to provide hold harmless payments to districts in the 2019-20 and 2020-21 school year based on the general apportionment amounts in the 2018-19 and 2019-20 school year and levy and local effort assistance (LEA) payments in the 2019 and 2020 calendar year, as compared to the 2017-18 school year general apportionment and 2018 calendar year levies and LEA.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

Increases General Fund - State by \$58,424,000.
