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9 On page 207, after line 5, insert the following:

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11 "(22) (a) In the 2019-20 school year, the superintendent of public
12 instruction must allocate hold harmless payments to school districts
13 as follows:

14 (i) A school district with an enrollment of three hundred or fewer
15 average annual full-time equivalent students will receive an amount
16 equal to number A minus number B if number A is greater than number B.

17 (ii) A school district with more than three hundred average annual
18 full-time equivalent students will receive the product of the
19 district's average annual full-time equivalent student enrollment in
20 the 2018-19 school year multiplied by an amount equal to number C
21 minus number D if number C is greater than number D.

22 (b) In the 2020-21 school year, the superintendent of public
23 instruction must allocate hold harmless payments to school districts
24 as follows:

25 (i) A school district with three hundred or fewer average annual
26 full-time equivalent students will receive an amount equal to number A
27 minus number E if number A is greater than number E.

1 (ii) A school district with more than three hundred average annual
2 full-time equivalent students will receive the product of the
3 district's average annual full-time equivalent students in the 2019-20
4 school year multiplied by an amount equal to number C minus number F
5 if number C is greater than number F.

6 (c) (i) "Number A" is the sum of the following:

7 (A) General apportionment provided to the school district in the
8 2017-18 school year, excluding the district's share of the general
9 apportionment allocation redirected by the superintendent to the
10 special education program;

11 (B) Local enrichment levies collected by the district in the 2018
12 calendar year; and

13 (C) Local effort assistance received by the district in the 2018
14 calendar year.

15 (ii) "Number B" is the sum of the following:

16 (A) General apportionment provided to the school district in the
17 2018-19 school year, excluding the district's share of the general
18 apportionment allocations redirected by the superintendent to the
19 special education program;

20 (B) Local enrichment levies collected by the district in the 2019
21 calendar year; and

22 (C) Local effort assistance received by the district in the 2019
23 calendar year.

24 (iii) "Number C" is the sum of the following divided by the
25 district's average annual full-time equivalent student enrollment in
26 the 2017-18 school year:

27 (A) General apportionment provided to the school district in the
28 2017-18 school year, excluding the district's share of the general
29 apportionment allocation redirected by the superintendent to the
30 special education program;

31 (B) Local enrichment levies collected by the district in the 2018
32 calendar year; and

33 (C) Local effort assistance received by the district in the 2018
34 calendar year.

1 (iv) "Number D" is the sum of the following divided by the
2 district's average annual full-time equivalent student enrollment in
3 the 2018-19 school year:

4 (A) General apportionment provided to the school district in the
5 2018-19 school year, excluding the district's share of the general
6 apportionment allocations redirected by the superintendent to the
7 special education program;

8 (B) Local enrichment levies collected by the district in the 2019
9 calendar year; and

10 (C) Local effort assistance received by the district in the 2019
11 calendar year.

12 (v) "Number E" is the sum of the following:

13 (A) General apportionment provided to the school district in the
14 2019-20 school year, excluding the district's share of the general
15 apportionment allocations redirected by the superintendent to the
16 special education program;

17 (B) Local enrichment levies collected by the district in the 2020
18 calendar year; and

19 (C) Local effort assistance received by the district in the 2020
20 calendar year.

21 (vi) "Number F" is the sum of the following divided by the
22 district's average annual full-time equivalent student enrollment in
23 the 2019-20 school year:

24 (A) General apportionment provided to the school district in the
25 2019-20 school year, excluding the district's share of the general
26 apportionment allocations redirected by the superintendent to the
27 special education program;

28 (B) Local enrichment levies collected by the district in the 2020
29 calendar year; and

30 (C) Local effort assistance received by the district in the 2020
31 calendar year."

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EFFECT: Requires the superintendent of public instruction to provide hold harmless payments to districts in the 2019-20 and 2020-21 school year based on the general apportionment amounts in the 2018-19 and 2019-20 school year and levy and local effort assistance (LEA) payments in the 2019 and 2020 calendar year, as compared to the 2017-18 school year general apportionment and 2018 calendar year levies and LEA.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Increases General Fund - State by \$58,424,000.

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
