14 (i) To receive the Washington college bound scholarship, a
15 student must graduate with at least a two point five grade point
16 average from a public high school or an approved private high school
17 under chapter 28A.195 RCW in Washington or have received home-based
18 instruction under chapter 28A.200 RCW, must have no felony
19 convictions, and must be a resident student as defined in RCW 28B.
20 15.012(2) (a) through (e). A student who is eligible to receive the
21 Washington college bound scholarship because the student is a
22 resident student under RCW 28B.15.012(2)(e) must provide the
23 institution, as defined in RCW 28B.15.012, an affidavit indicating
24 that the individual will file an application to become a permanent
25 resident at the earliest opportunity the individual is eligible to
26 do so and a willingness to engage in any other activities necessary

1 to acquire citizenship, including but not limited to citizenship or
2 civics review courses.

3 (ii) For eligible children as defined in subsection (1)(b) and
4 (c) of this section, to receive the Washington college bound
5 scholarship, a student must have received a high school equivalency
6 certificate as provided in RCW 28B.50.536 or have graduated with at
7 least a two point five grade point average from a public high school
8 or an approved private high school under chapter 28A.195 RCW in
9 Washington or have received home-based instruction under chapter
10 28A.200 RCW, must have no felony convictions, and must be a resident
11 student as defined in RCW 28B.15.012(2) (a) through (e).

12 For a student who does not meet the two point five grade point
13 average requirement, and who completes fewer than two quarters in
14 the running start program, under chapter 28A.600 RCW, the student's
15 first quarter of running start course grades must be excluded from
16 the student's overall grade point average for purposes of
17 determining their eligibility to receive the scholarship."

EFFECT: Changes the grade requirement for College Bound
Scholarship (CBS) eligibility from a "C" average to a 2.5 grade
point average for students who sign the CBS pledge, beginning with
the 2019-20 academic year.
