12 pledge beginning with the 2019-20 academic year:

13 (i) To receive the Washington college bound scholarship, a
14 student must graduate with at least a "C" average from a public high
15 school or an approved private high school under chapter 28A.195 RCW
16 in Washington or have received home-based instruction under chapter
17 28A.200 RCW, must have no gross misdemeanor or felony convictions,
18 and must be a resident student as defined in RCW 28B.15.012(2) (a)
19 through (e). A student who is eligible to receive the Washington
20 college bound scholarship because the student is a resident student
21 under RCW 28B.15.012(2)(e) must provide the institution, as defined
22 in RCW 28B.15.012, an affidavit indicating that the individual will
23 file an application to become a permanent resident at the earliest
24 opportunity the individual is eligible to do so and a willingness to
25 engage in any other activities necessary to acquire citizenship,
26 including but not limited to citizenship or civics review courses.

1 (ii) For eligible children as defined in subsection (1)(b) and
2 (c) of this section, to receive the Washington college bound
3 scholarship, a student must have received a high school equivalency
4 certificate as provided in RCW 28B.50.536 or have graduated with at
5 least a "C" average from a public high school or an approved private
6 high school under chapter 28A.195 RCW in Washington or have received
7 home-based instruction under chapter 28A.200 RCW, must have no gross
8 misdemeanor or felony convictions, and must be a resident student as
9 defined in RCW 28B.15.012(2) (a) through (e).

10 For a student who does not meet the "C" average requirement, and
11 who completes fewer than two quarters in the running start program,
12 under chapter 28A.600 RCW, the student's first quarter of running
13 start course grades must be excluded from the student's overall
14 grade point average for purposes of determining their eligibility to
15 receive the scholarship."

EFFECT: Requires a College Bound Scholarship (CBS) student who signed the CBS pledge in the 2019-20 academic year or later to have no gross misdemeanor or felony convictions, rather than no felony convictions, in order to be eligible for the CBS.
