- 10 enrolled in two consecutive years who visited the same practice or
- 11 clinical entity in both years; and
- 12 (c) A ten to twelve percent decrease in the number of children
- 13 aged one to twenty-one with dental caries experience in their primary
- 14 and permanent teeth.
- 15 (2) The health care authority shall inform the code reviser if
- 16 these metrics have been met no later than January 31, 2024."
